As part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav programme, Haranadh visited the homes of local freedom fighters in Jagatsinghpur namely Madhabananda Manohari of Nuapara village, Bhagirathi Swain of Ichhapur village & Jogendra Maharana of Aanlla village and felicitated them. During the course of interaction, the freedom fighters described how they in their adolescent time participated in the freedom struggle and contributed to the nation-building exercise, in the postindependence era. Haranadh, Chairman, PPT wished them healthy lives and urged the younger generations to be inspired by these living patriots. A.K. Bose, Dy. Chairman and P.N. Bahekar, Secretary, PPT were also present on the occasion.

#### **TPNODL SETS AN EXAMPLE IN NORTHERN ODISHA**

PNODL has been able to set an example in the entire northern Odisha. The company took over the charge of electricity distribution for Balasore, Bhadrak, Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar and Jajpur districts on April 1 last year. In the last nine months, it has been observed that the company has been able to protect consumer interest and bring in better-than-expected reforms regarding quality service and provision for safety. Due to responsible officers and dedicated workflow of duty bound employees, it can be safely concluded that electricity consumers in the five districts are assured these days. The issues of unscheduled power cuts and low voltages issues have been resolved to a large extent. The company has increased support staff for maintenance and repairing work. The transformers have now secured boundaries and the substations are upgraded these days.

The scenes of overhead power cables hanging in dangerously low positions are not seen anymore. All the poles and wires of 11kV, 33kV and LT are now strengthened. Similarly, the poles now have a concrete foundation. All the employees and labourers have been provided with safety equipment. All of them have been given training via special camps. As a result, there has been a drop in cases of accidents. There has been an increase of the labour force keeping in mind the number of electricity consumers while low voltage issues have dropped than earlier days. More importantly, there has been a significant drop in the number of power cuts in rural areas at the time of heavy rains and increased wind speed. Number of transformers also has been increased keeping in mind the number of consumers. A notable development has been the change of electricity substations and transformers which were in risky positions earlier. Each transformer has been encircled either with concrete boundaries or strong wire fencing to provide protection for animals and children. All the poles and wires of 11kV, 33kV and LT are now strengthened. Similarly, the poles now have a concrete foundation.

A special team is now looking after the poles, wires and transformers. These days there has been no instances of fuse cut due to fall of tree branches on wires nor the electric wires are seen hanging both in the cities and rural areas. No electric poles have been kept under construction in the district. More than one strong 'stay' has kept the poles strong, said a senior official of TPNODL. According to his information, as the total consumer base has become 19.9 lakh in 5 districts i.e. Balasore, Bhadrak, Mayurbhani, Jaipur, Keonihar and the number of transformers have been increased to 71,358. The number of PSS has been increased to 228 and that of power transformers to 505 keeping in mind the large consumer base. Similarly, number of employees has also increased. While contractual agencies have been hired for some work, the number of employees and field workers have been raised. Along with the previously employed workforce. a total of 7195 employees have been appointed to look after electric wires, poles and transformers. Similarly for meter billing collection 1522 and for meter replacing work 447 personnel have been engaged. All the employees and labourers have been provided with safety equipment. All of them have been given training via special camps. As a result, there has been a drop in cases of accidents. Due to regular inspection and maintenance, sometimes there are power cuts for 2-3 hours, but consumers are notified ahead of the power cut. A modern system has been adopted for bill collection. Consumers can now pay bills conveniently from their homes. A complaint redressal counter has been opened to deal with issues of power supply swiftly. There are also provisions for receiving complaints online.
